SENIOR SUPA SERIES DESCRIPTION

Bowls SA runs a Senior Supa Series flagship event for bowlers over the age of 60, that attracts participants and visitors from both intrastate and interstate. The competition provides a pathway for athletes to represent South Australia on the national stage. Seniors events are well supported by the bowls community and are designed to tap into the demographic that is eager and in a position to travel and play, with social interaction as a major attraction to this tournament.

The role of the event is to raise funds for the Senior Nationals and become a national pathway event for selection. The event is unique to the state being the only tournament for over 60 bowlers.

All over 60's bowlers are welcome to enter in the event, no team or member of any competing team will be subject to any restrictions on the grounds of race, religion or sexual orientation. Please use the criteria below as a guide and outline the club's ability to meet the criteria where possible.

Please use the criteria, listed below, as a guide for compiling your club's tender documents, outlining the club's ability to meet the criteria where possible; also including any additional information in support of your submission, which may assist Bowls SA in determining the most suitable host clubs for these events. Submissions for hosting of the events over multiple years will also be considered.

All tender documents should be directed to the Operations Manager and are required to be received at Bowls SA by the close of business, **Friday 23 July 2021**.

EVENT INFORMATION

- Discipline – Medley of Pairs and Fours with Fours played in the morning, Pairs over lunch and to finish the day with Fours.
- Date of the event – 10th and 11th of January 2022.
- Number of official days – 2
- Minimum of two greens with 16 rinks are required to a suitable standard (13-16 seconds).
- The venues being utilised must establish effective liaison between their green keepers so that all of the venues reach a high degree of uniformity in pace and performance. All greens must be of a suitable standard of performance and must conform to the requirements of Laws of the Sport of Bowls.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- Provision of venues.
- Lunch at venue during the event for competing teams to be \$15 per person (included in entry fee).
- Accredited umpires to be present for all days of play.
- Supply of drinking water.
- Changing rooms, adequate toilets and secure lockers for players and officials.
- Catering and toilet facilities for spectators.
- First aid facilities and personnel at all venues.
- Car parking arrangements, spectator seating, and public announcement systems.
- Tournament event area or office, where necessary include equipment, connections, computer, printer and photocopying facilities, adequate phone, fax and internet.
- Arrangements for any on-site retail facilities i.e. trading tables, chairs.

- Supply of all equipment required in field of play, i.e. mats, jacks, scoreboards, umpires equipment etc.
- Signage at venues in consultation with Bowls SA in respect to Senior Supa Series sponsors and commercial partners.
- Relevant insurance cover to host event in consultation with Bowls SA.
- Provide a staffed bar, proceeds of which will go directly to the host club
- Host clubs must provide an area for event approved sponsors when requested. Host club sponsors must not directly conflict with the sponsorship of the event and/or Bowls SA.
