Appendix 1 – ASADA Sports Integrity Requirements

All Elite Squad Athletes upon signing of this contract are expected to complete the Anti-Doping training as required to compete in Bowls Australia Events.

All Bowls SA Elite Squad contracted Athletes must complete the Anti-Doping Fundamentals and Sport Integrity Australia Annual Update Courses within one month of accepting their offered place in the squad, or as soon as deemed necessary by upcoming events.

The Sport Integrity Australia Annual Update Course is required to be updated each year, with the Sports Integrity E-Learning system upgrading the Sport Integrity Australia Annual Update Course at the beginning of each Calendar year.

For those completing the Sport Integrity eLearning Courses for the first time, you will need to complete the <u>Anti-Doping Fundamentals (previously ASADA Level 1)</u>. You will only need to complete this course once.

Please note – if you have previously completed the ASADA Level 1 course, you do **NOT** have to do this Sport Integrity Australia course – it is the same one.

All completed courses will be display in your elearning account under the My Learning Tab.

For those that have previously completed either the Sport Integrity Level 1 Anti-doping course (or the previous ASADA Level 1 course), then each year you only need to complete the **Annual Update**. This is the equivalent of the previous ASADA Level 2 which was also required to be completed annually.

All players are also required to complete the Introduction to Competition Manipulation and Sports Betting eLearning module. This was previously completed on a different website and was called Match-Fixing. It is now housed on the one Sport Integrity website called Introduction to Match Fixing. The updates for this course are included in the Annual Update so you will only need to complete this course once. If you have completed the previous version of this course (Keep Sport Honest), then you do not have to complete this Sport Integrity Australia course.
