



## **Australian Indoor Championships Conditions of Play 2025**

**State Qualifying:** Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2025

**State Final:** Wallaroo Bowling Club – Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2025

**National Final:** Club Tweed NSW – 11 to 14 August 2025

Where possible, the event should be run at either an indoor or a completely covered facility with an artificial surface. If this cannot be achieved, the event must be run at an outdoor facility with an artificial surface.

### **For Qualifying**

The Bowls SA 2024/25 State Events Conditions of Play will apply to the Australian Indoor Qualifying event (SA). The following conditions will apply and over-rule any conditions that state otherwise;

1. Format
  - 1.1 Four bowls per player.
  - 1.2 Sectional play – 3 people in each section.
    - 1.2.1 Following completion of the sectionals, some winners may be required to play Knockouts at the same venue, where the below State Finals conditions will apply.
  - 1.3 Sets play as per Laws 56.1 and 56.2 – 2 sets of 9 ends with a 3-end tie-break if required.
  - 1.4 Jack re-spotted on the T.
  - 1.5 One trial end in each direction prior to the commencement of each game.
2. Restricted Movement of Player
  - 2.1 The opponents: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
  - 2.2 In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Singles player can ask the Marker for permission to walk up to the head earlier than prescribed.
  - 2.3 If a player does not meet the terms of this clause, then Law 13 (Possession of the Rink) will apply.

### **For State Finals**

The Bowls SA 2024/25 State Events Conditions of Play will apply to the Australian Indoor Qualifying event (SA). The following conditions will apply and over-rule any conditions that state otherwise.

1. Format
  - 1.1 Four bowls per player.
  - 1.2 Knockout Play
  - 1.3 Sets play as per Laws 56.1 and 56.2 – 2 sets of 9 ends with a 3-end tie-break if required.
  - 1.4 Jack re-spotted on the T.
  - 1.5 One trial end in each direction prior to the commencement of each game.
2. Restricted Movement of Player
  - 2.1 The opponents: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
  - 2.2 In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Singles player can ask the Marker for permission to walk up to the head.
  - 2.3 If a player does not meet the terms of this clause, then Law 13 (Possession of the Rink) will apply.
